This 3-year program provides farmers the opportunity to start their own farm business. Each farmer receives a 1/4 acre of plowed, fenced, and

fertilized farmland. Farmers also receive access to 20+ agricultural and business workshops per year, 1-on-1 technical assistance, marketing opportunities, tools, seeds, and plants.
