Cultivating farmer-led and community-rooted agriculture and food systems to actualize the rights of under-resourced peoples.



Programs

INCUBATOR FARM



This 3-year program provides farmers the opportunity to start their own farm business.

Each farmer receives a 1/4 acre of plowed, fenced, and fertilized farmland. Farmers also receive

access to 20+ agricultural and business workshops per year, 1-on-1 technical assistance, marketing opportunities, tools, seeds, plants, and the opportunity for land tenancy upon program completion.

COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION FARM



Community organizations receive 1/2- to 5-acre plots of prepared farmland. Participating organizations also receive access to agricultural resources and educational opportunities.

Organizations focus on building food security and increased access to traditional foods within their communities.

CSA



Community-supported agriculture (CSA) is a system in which farmers partner with community members to provide a local source of fresh produce. Community members purchasing a

CSA share receive a variety of freshly picked farm produce weekly throughout the growing season.

PRODUCE AGGREGATION FOR FOOD PANTRIES



Through this grassroots, community-led solution to bolstering fresh food access, every week PFC aggregates produce from its farmers, paying them fair wholesale prices and donating this

produce to food pantries in Western New York
